Medical Procedures Checklist Tourniquet

Indications for use:

Bleeding in an extremity that is not controlled by direct pressure

Contra-indications:

Bleeding that can be controlled by other means

Application:

- 1. Place around extremity. just above the injury (Do not place on a joint)
- 2. Ensure snug fit and secure strap
- 3. Tighten windlass until bleeding is controlled
- 4. Secure windlass
- 5. Mark "TK" and time applied on patient's forehead
- 6. Administer high flow oxygen via BVM or NRB
