#### **Chief and Committee Reports**

<u>Chief Mulvey:</u> recognized employees and volunteers service awards for 2020; reported on fire and EMS run times and call volume; EMS billables for January were lower then expected. Chief and Major Neal will contact 911 Billing to discuss; reported on surplus items; has been appointed by KY Fire Chief's Board to the legislative committee. Reported on HB44; PRN T.J. Stigers and B. Dant have asked to be removed from our PRN list. Motion Shewmaker, 2<sup>nd</sup> Bauer to remove Stigers and Dant from our roster of PRNs. MC

<u>Deputy Chief Storrie:</u> reported that the HGAC proposals for the new apparatus should be available by March 5<sup>th</sup> and committee hopes to report to this Board by the April meeting; ISO report is still not available; reported on Fireman's fund.

<u>Deputy Chief Evans:</u> training has resumed, and we continue to follow CDC guidelines; reported on the Health Departments latest COVID-19 guidelines; ESO progress continues; new recruit class begins next week. Motion

Shewmaker, 2<sup>nd</sup> Brown to accept new recruits as members of the Department based on the Chief's recommendation. MC

<u>Lt. Col. Hutchens:</u> Covid is still restricting events; working on 2021/2022 budget submissions.

<u>Major Neal:</u> will be traveling to Braun 2/22 – 2/24 to pick up the ambulances. (Pierce reported she will be completing loan documents on 2/16 with Park Community); 6 new EMS positions have been posted for positions that will begin in April; 7182 is back in service; David Price (PRN) has had no contact with us since beginning of his employment last March. Neal to send a certified letter to D. Price regarding his intentions of future employment with the Department; Advanced EMT class will be completed soon; 3 PRNs are interested in becoming full time.

<u>Major Schmidt:</u> reported on recent line of duty deaths. A moment of silence was observed. <u>Major Elstone</u>: reported on various new construction throughout the district and the possibility of flood plain restrictions being revised.

## **New Business**

- Sick leave policy revision was presented and discussed. Policy will be revised based on discussion and presented again in March.
- Motion Bauer, 2<sup>nd</sup> Deloch to accept engagement letter received from Jones Nale & Mattingly for FYE 06/2021 audit - cost will not exceed \$12,100. MC
- Term expirations: Susan Pierce (Mayor appointed) and Eric Brown (Firefighter Elected) terms will expire June 30, 2021. Notification will be sent to the Mayor's office for the expiration of Pierce's term. Motion Bauer, 2<sup>nd</sup> Brown to recommend to the Mayor's office that Pierce be reappointed. MC *a letter will be sent to the Mayor's office for this recommendation*
- Chief has received 3 bids for the station # 1 bathroom renovations (budgeted under buildings and additions). Elite Restoration won the bid at \$59,939. Transparency note: Colonel Hutchens is the owner of this business. Project will be postponed for 45-60 days.
